

HCSC IN ACTION: JULY 2026

Hyderabad City Security Council continues to lead high-impact initiatives across women and child safety, cybersecurity, physical security, traffic safety, anti-narcotics, and CSR- strengthening community resilience and safety across Hyderabad.



Key Meetings & Highlights

- To strengthen the safety of women and girl students staying in hostels and paying guest (PG) accommodations, the Hyderabad City Police has launched 'Project Safe Stay', making registration of all women's hostels and PGs with the local police mandatory. The initiative was launched jointly by Hyderabad Police Commissioner Shri VC Sajjanar and GHMC Commissioner RV Karnan at the TGICCC Auditorium, Banjara Hills.
- The program, launched in collaboration with the Hyderabad City Security Council (HCSC) and United Way of Hyderabad, also saw the release of the Suraksha Nivas 1.0 guidelines brochure, aimed at establishing minimum safety standards for women's accommodation facilities across the city.
- The Hyderabad Traffic Police, in collaboration with the Hyderabad City Security Council (HCSC), on Saturday, July 18, inducted 30 new traffic patrol bikes into service to strengthen traffic management and improve emergency response across the city. Hyderabad Police Commissioner Shri V.C. Sajjanar flagged off the bikes in the presence of Joint Commissioner of Police (Traffic) Shri D. Joel Davis and senior officials. Addressing the gathering, Shri Sajjanar said the induction of 30 Avenger patrol bikes, procured with CSR contributions, has increased the city's operational traffic patrol bike fleet to 80 from the existing 50. The additional vehicles would enable quicker responses to traffic congestion, road accidents and vehicle breakdowns while strengthening enforcement activities across Hyderabad. Traffic Marshal sponsors were also felicitated during this event.
- The Executive Committee of HCSC met for its 22nd meeting held on 14-07-2026 at ICC, Banjara Hills, Hyderabad. The meeting was chaired by the Chairman Shri V.C Sajjanar, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Hyderabad.

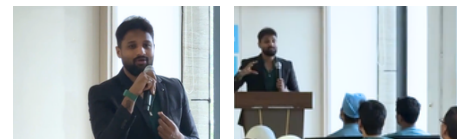
